



Cam FM and Coronavirus (COVID-19) Statement 3

This statement is released further to our previous statements of 14th March and 18th March, and following an announcement from Anglia Ruskin University that all non-essential university buildings are to be closed at 5pm on Sunday 22nd March.

As a result of this announcement, it is our duty, with heavy hearts, to inform members that the ARU studio will be closed from 5pm on Sunday 22nd March. No shows will be broadcast from ARU from this time, until further notice. Members should not count on access to the studio after 5pm this Sunday, even in an emergency.

The Fitz studio remains due to close from 5pm today, as per our prior statement.

All training sessions for the foreseeable future are to be cancelled.

Members should be assured that we fully expect the computers in both our studios to remain running, necessary for Cam FM broadcasts (including the Playout system) despite the absence of studio access.
